Bible Story Story Time

Jesus Taught about Prayer (Matt. 4:23-35; 5:1; 6:5-14)

Flip, flop, flip, flop went Jesus' sandals as He walked throughout Galilee, teaching and healing the sick. Everywhere Jesus went, crowds of people followed Him to hear the news of God's love and to see the amazing things Jesus would do.

One day, a crowd gathered around Jesus; so He went up on the hillside along with His disciples and began to teach. Jesus taught a lot of important things that day, but one thing He talked about was prayer. Jesus said, "Don't pray to show off to other people or just so people will hear you. Prayer is a special time between you and God." Jesus told His helpers when they prayed to pray something like this:

"Father we honor Your name. Do on Earth what You would do in heaven. Give us the food we will need today.

Forgive us when we do wrong, and help us forgive those who do wrong to us. Keep us from doing unkind things. We know You are powerful and wonderful forever, Amen."

Talk Time

- **1.** Show the teaching picture for today's Bible story. Ask the following: "What did Jesus talk to the people about? Do you remember some things Jesus asked us to pray about?
- 2. Read the Bible Phrase on the colouring picture. Say the phrase together. Express to children that God wants us to talk to Him. We can talk to Him when we are happy, sad; afraid, mad, lonely or sick. God wants us also to thank Him and praise Him for all the things He has done and given us.

3. Close the Bible Story Time by giving the children an opportunity to


pray. End the prayer by thanking God that Jesus taught us how to pray and for God hearing our prayers.
